# **ANTI RAGGING CELL** AND **ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023**

In conformity with Supreme Court judgements and directions, UGC guidelines and State Government Instructions, Bharat Institutions are following 'Zero-Tolerance policy' towards ragging. Any student of Bharat institute on accused and found guilty of ragging, will be severely dealt with, in accordance with the Provisions of the Law.

Ragging in all its forms shall be completely banned in this Institution including in its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, kiosks, cafeteria and the like) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. The Institution shall take strict action including but not limited to criminal proceeding and/or cancellation of admission against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging, and subject to circumstances, the burden of proof may lie on the perpetrator of alleged ragging and not on the victim. The University is bound by the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009 dated 17 June 2009, as Gazetted on 4 July 2009 and the amendments thereto from time to time.

To build a ragging free environment by instilling the principles of democratic values, tolerance, empathy, compassion and sensitivity so that students become responsible citizens.

#### **Anti-RaggingPolicy**

According to the UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Institutions, 2009, ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- 1. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- 2. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- 3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- 4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- 5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- 6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- 7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, and stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harmer any other danger to health or person.
- 8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, and public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfit to fresher or any other student.
- 9. Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.

#### **Punishments**

According to the UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, those found guilty may be awarded one or more of the following punishments, namely;

- ❖ Warning, writing apology letter.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- ❖ Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- With holding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- \* Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

- ❖ To consider the complaints received from the students and conduct inquiries and submit reports to the Anti-Ragging Committee along with punishment recommended for the offenders.
- Oversee the procedure of obtaining an undertaking from the students in accordance with the provisions.
- Conduct workshops against ragging menace and orient the students.
- To provide students the information pertaining to the contact address and telephone numbers of the person(s) identified to receive complaints/distress calls.
- ❖ To offer services of counseling and create awareness for the students.
- ❖ To take all necessary measures for prevention of Ragging inside the Campus.




