### Blood clotting:-

the clot is the network where the 'insoluble' protein fibre (fibrin) is formed. the elements of the blood is trapped. the clotting involves several substances called clotting factors (coagulation). the clotting includes the  $Ca^{++}$  and several inactivated substances (fibrinogen and prothrombin) (synthesised by liver cells and then released into the blood stream).

### clotting factors include:

- I Fibrinogen
- II Prothrombin
- III Thromboplastin
- IV calcium ions
- V Labiel factor (Proaccelerin)
- VI No longer needed
- VII stable factor (Proconvertin)
- VIII Antihæmophilic factor (A) (AHF-A)
- IX Christmas factor (AHF-B)
- X Stuart Power factor
- XI Plasma thromboplastin Anticident factor c (AHF-c)
- XII Hagemann factor
- XIII Fibrin stabilising factor.
